

Key stage three art is the foundation course for the Fine Art GCSE course and because of this the basis of KS3 art is centered on developing a range of strong objective drawing skills.

Students also have the opportunity to explore a range of materials as well as developing an appreciation of art by looking at and responding to the work of other artists

Students study the themes of natural forms, still life and portraiture. As well as studying the work of other artists as students develop work and ideas they also have the opportunity to develop skills using all traditional drawing tools, paint, print and the development of three dimensional thought.
