<u>Word</u>	Meaning
Hard Engineering	Using concrete or large artificial structures to defend against natural coastal processes
Soft Engineering	Managing erosion by working with natural processes to help restore beaches and coastal ecosystems
Urban Sprawl	Unplanned growth of urban areas into the surrounding rural area
Greenfield Site	A plot of land, often in a rural area on the edge of an urban area that has not been built on before
Urban Greening	Process of increasing and preserving open space in urban areas e.g. public parks / gardens
Transnational Corporation (TNC)	A company that has operations (factories, offices, research and development) in more than one country
Emerging Economies	A country that experiences rapid economic development
