Word - *Meaning*

Colour Wheel -

A circle showing the relationship between colours.

Contrast -

The obvious difference between things e.g. light/dark.

Sketching -

A loose drawing technique used to establish the outline and shapes of something.

Gradation -

Creating shade in terms of light to dark.
