Empire	Land that is ruled by a single country or nation, such as Rome.
Emperor	The ruler of an Empire
Conquer	To take control of a place by force
Government	A group of people who make decisions and enforce laws.
Myth	A story that is told to explain how something began.
Villein	Peasants who worked on the Lord's land.
Freemen	Paid rent to the Lord to farm their land. They were paid wages.
Archaeology	Examining the remains of the past.
Revolt	A violent attempt to overthrow the leaders or government.
