Semiotics	Communicating meaning via, set,costume,props
Voice	When performing: volume, pace, pitch, clarity, tone, pause
Dialogue	Speech by two or more characters.
Montage	Very short scenes combined for impact
Flashback	Non time linear technique
Storyboard	Pictorial way of plotting a storyline
Role on the Wall	Written convention to explore character
Devise	To create own script through improvisation and research.
Tension	Highs and lows of dramatic journey
Multi-role	An actor playing more than one character in a single performance
Monologue	Speech by one
