Urbanisation	The development of villages, towns and cities
Densely / sparsely populated	Whether an area has lots of people or very few people living there
Wave-cut platform	A narrow flat area found at the base of cliffs in coastal areas formed by erosion
Erosion	The breakdown and removal of material
Longshore drift	The transportation of sediment along a coastline in the direction of the prevailing wind
Employment structure	How a workforce is divided between different sectors
Industry	Economic activity e.g. processing raw materials and manufacturing
Newly- emerging economy	An economy which is growing rapidly and outpacing other developing countries
