Starting Monday 15 April, we will be changing the Management Information System used in school from SIMS to Arbor, a comprehensive and user-friendly platform designed to consolidate various systems used throughout the school. A MIS is the system schools use for student and staff data.

Moving forward, we will gradually introduce the Arbor Parent App for communicating with parents. Arbor offers a more integrated solution that will not only facilitate better communication but also provide you with a convenient way to track your child's behaviour and receive your child's school records.

The benefits of this transition include:

- Consolidation of information: All school-related information, including messages, attendance, and behaviour records, will be accessible from a single platform.
- User-friendly interface: Arbor is designed with a user-friendly interface, making it easier for parents to navigate and access important information about their child's academic journey.
- Real-time updates: You will receive timely and accurate updates about your child's attendance, behaviour, and school activities.
- Efficient communication: The new system will streamline communication channels, ensuring that you receive important messages promptly.

We will send further communication in the coming months to advise when we will launch the Parent App, so there is nothing you need to do or should expect to see at this stage.

To help with the transition, we will also provide a simple user guide on how to access and navigate Arbor's Parent Portal and make the most of its features. Our aim is to make the transition as smooth as possible for you and your child.
