WHAT IS BULLYING?

Bullying...

- deliberately threatens someone's health, safety or well-being
- deliberately causes someone distress
- is intentional (not an accident)
- is repetitive
- can be done by one person or a group of people
- can happen online
- is not an argument with a friend
- is not a one-off fight or comment
- isn't not wanting to be friends with someone



Do...

- try to tell the bully to stop ٠
- tell a trusted adult or a friend ٠
- speak to your Form Tutor
- speak to your Pastoral Manager or ٠ Head of Learning
- Email noroomforhate@stm.srscmat.co.uk ٠ Don't...
- copy the behaviour of the bully ٠
- do it back to them •
- join in with the bullying behaviour
- stand by and do nothing

STM School procedure

- Form tutor or pastoral team will investigate and record the incident
- Where incidents are proven, all parents will be told and asked to support any action taken by the school
