The Y11 Mock GCSE exams are an important preparation for your GCSEs in the Summer.

There will be an Assembly and a walk-through of the exam arrangements in advance of these mock exams.

The morning exams start at 9 am and the afternoon exams start at 1:20pm (including on a Wednesday). Please ensure you place your bag on the stage and line up outside the Sports building at least 10 minutes before the start of your exam. Phones and watches may be left in the 'red' box which will be with a member of staff when you are lining up outside the PE block.

When you do not have an exam please go to your usual timetabled lessons.

Please make sure that you have all the equipment you need for your examination, in a clear pencil case. A Black Biro, pencil, ruler, eraser and a scientific calculator for selected examinations, is a minimum requirement. Clear water bottles without labels or logos are allowed in the exam room, food is not allowed. School uniform must be worn.

NO MOBILE PHONES, NO WATCHES, NO EAR BUDS/HEADPHONES and NO POTENTIAL TECHNOLOGICAL/WEB ENABLED SOURCES OF INFORMATION are allowed in the exam room.

Please make sure you know the JCQ rules of the exam room:

1. You must be on time for all your examinations.
2. Possession of a mobile phone or other unauthorised material is not allowed even if you do not intend to use it. You will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification from the exam/qualification.
3. You must not talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates once you have entered the examination room.
4. You must follow the instructions of the invigilator.
5. You must not sit an examination in the name of another candidate.
6. You must not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice in any part of the examination.
7. If you are confused about anything, speak only to an invigilator.

If you have any queries about these exams, please talk to your teachers or Form Tutor in the first instance or see the exams officer - Mrs Liz Taylor (the exams office is near the Chapel).
