As we approach the end of this term, I wanted to take the opportunity to reflect on what has been an incredibly busy but productive year at St Thomas More. It is hard to believe it has been nearly a year since I returned to work here, and I must say that the renewal and progress we have experienced has brought me immense joy.

This term has been a particularly successful one for St Thomas More. We have achieved so much as a school community, and I am immensely proud of everyone's contributions. The final week has been full of festive spirit, culminating today in a beautiful liturgy and our legendary STM Christmas Karaoke spectacular – an entertaining way to end the term.

Last Friday, we were honoured to host the Senior Citizens Christmas Party, an event that was wonderfully covered by the BBC. Looking ahead, I am pleased to share some updates regarding staffing and structures:

- From January, our SEND Team will have a new structure. Mrs Sharon Light has been promoted to SEND Manager, and Mrs Sahinkaya will step into the role of HLTA. To strengthen the team further, we are recruiting an additional permanent TA as well as a temporary TA role. Mrs Lancett will be in touch with families of children with additional needs with more information.
- Miss Lucy Brocklesby will be transitioning from her role on reception to a promoted position as Inclusion Manager, while also retaining her responsibilities as Attendance Officer. A new receptionist will join us towards the end of January.
- We continue our search for a permanent, high-quality teacher of Chemistry and will resume this work in January.
