Dear Parents and Carers,

Monday 6th October – St Francis of Assisi Feast Day

I am delighted to say that our Year 8 students have had an extremely positive return to St Thomas More after the summer. I very much look forward to working with them again, during their second year as their Head of Learning.

As part of our Catholic Social Teaching programme, each year group has adopted a Saint to learn more about and look at the examples set in which we can follow. For Year 8, we have chosen Saint St Francis of Assisi who is the patron saint of ecology and animals and promoted looked after nature.

On Monday 6th October, we invite the children to celebrate the Feast Day of St Francis. On this day, the Year 8 students are permitted to attend school in non-uniform for a voluntary £1 donation.

The Year 8 students will also be raising money by way of a sponsored litter pick (weather permitted) around our local community. We would like to conduct the litter pick on Monday 6th but if weather does not permit, we will move this to another date and we will communicate this with you closer to the time.

Finally, as part of the day, we will be walking up to St Anne's Church on Terrace Road for a Liturgy. This will take place during the school day and so alternative transportation to and from school does not need to be arranged.

We kindly ask that you support the children in their fundraiser by asking friends and relatives for a small sponsorship donation. The children will be coming home with a sponsorship form, or you may use the sheet attached. All monies raised on the day will go to the Year 8's chosen charity: RSPCA. Children can give their collected sponsorship to their Form Tutor by Monday 13th October. There will also be a JustGiving link sent out via text, which you can share with anyone who wishes to sponsor with card payment rather than cash.
